THE REVERSIBLE BIKING HAT by indigorchid

A lightweight hat that covers the ears, with interesting stitch-pattern on both sides.



Measurements

- Gauge: 24 sts to 4 inches in stitch pattern (6 repeats)
- Sizes: S (M)
- Circumference: 16"/41 cm (18"/46 cm)
- Height: 8 "/20 cm (9"/23 cm)

Materials needed

- Sport weight yarn (12-14 wpi), 30 grams
- Circular knitting needles 16 inches, double pointed needles, both size US 2 ½/3 mm
- Tapestry needle to weave in the ends

Techniques

Casting on, knit stitches (k), purl stitches (p), yarn over (yo), knit two together (k2tog), slip one st, k1, pass the slipped st over the knit st (skp), slip one st, k2tog, pass the slipped st over the knit sts (sl1, k2tog, psso).

Pattern

With circular needles, cast on 96 (112) stitches and join.

Rw 1-6: *k3, p1, repeat from *

until end of row

Rw 7: *k2, skp, yo, repeat

Rw 8-11: *k3, p1, repeat

Rw 12: *k2, skp, yo, repeat

Rw 13-62: repeat rows 8-12

ten times, or until piece measures ap-

proximately 7" (8")

Decrease:

row 1: *k2tog, k1, p1, k3, p1, repeat (84 (98) sts left)

row 2: *k2, p1, k2tog, k1, p1, repeat (72 (84) sts)

row 3: *skp, p1, k2, p1, repeat (60 (70) sts)

row 4: *k1, p1, skp, p1, repeat (48 (56) sts)

row 5: switch to dpn, *k1, p1, repeat (48 (56) sts)

row 6: *sl1, k2tog, psso, p1, repeat (24 (28) sts)

row 7-8: *k1, p1, repeat (24(28)sts)

row 9: *sl1, k2tog, psso, p1, repeat (12 (14) sts)

row 10: *k1, p1, repeat (12(14)sts)

Cut tail, pull through remaining sts, tighten, and weave in ends.
